

# PROVIDING HEALTH OUTREACH SERVICES IN GEORGIA

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CORE (Community Organized Relief Effort) is a crisis response organization that brings immediate aid and recovery to underserved communities across the globe. CORE Georgia's Health Outreach Program works to increase education and support communities facing COVID-19 health disparities by providing benefits navigation, resource coordination, and health education. CORE Georgia provides health outreach services in partnership with the Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) and the Department of Children and Family Services (DFCS). Health Outreach Coordinators (HOC) are critical to CORE Georgia's work in emergency relief, community building, and public health. HOC are knowledgeable of local government and community-based organizations, community resources, and processes for receiving services. HOC are the link between the community and resources available.

#### **BENEFITS NAVIGATION**

CORE has partnered with Georgia Gateway to assist individuals with applications for government assistance such as WIC, TANF, SNAP, and Medicaid.

## **RESOURCE COORDINATION**

In addition to government assistance, CORE works to identify and provide referrals to community based organizations.

### **HEALTH EDUCATION**

Through community outreach and mobilization, CORE provides educational resources regarding COVID and other public health services as well as coordination with community partners to organize health fairs and vaccine events.
